It is with great satisfaction that the Eurail Group is publishing this 2009 Eurail Traveler's Guide. This year we are celebrating the 50th anniversary of the Eurail Pass and with it 50 years of successful European Rail travel.

Eurail gives you access to Europe's growing network of routes and destinations. European trains are, on the whole, reliable, fast, safe and comfortable and play an important role in your experience of Europe.

This booklet has been designed to help you enjoy your journey in Europe providing essential information on how to use the Eurail Pass and how to deal with reservations. It outlines the Pass Benefits and presents you with a number of many helpful hints and tips.

By choosing to travel with a Eurail Pass on Europe's trains, you are using one of the most environmentally-friendly modes of transportation.

Thank you for choosing Eurail, enjoy your trip!



This guide also includes very important information on how to use Your pass correctly. We have highlighted these passages for You: please pay special attention to information marked with this symbol →.



Where can I use my Eurail Pass?

Eurail Global Passes are valid in all 21 countries listed on your pass cover. For Eurail Select, Regional and One Country Passes, your pass is valid in the country or countries which are printed on the pass itself.

Your Eurail Pass entitles you to travel on the national railways in all of these countries, as well as on various private railways.

How to use your Eurail Pass

Check your Eurail Pass carefully

When you receive your Eurail Pass, check it very carefully to ensure all of the details are correct. If there is a mistake, then you will need to return to the point of purchase to have it corrected.

Remember, your Eurail Pass is like cash – so guard it accordingly! Eurail does not grant refunds on lost or stolen passes, or for passes that have only been partially used. In addition, you must make sure you have all the documents needed to travel in the countries you plan to visit, including a valid passport and any required visas. It's also important to note that travel insurance is not included in the price of your pass. We highly recommend that you buy full travel insurance coverage.



Validate your Eurail Pass

Before you board your first train, please have a close look at your pass: the first and last dates of validity have to be filled in. Do not fill in the dates yourself! This is not allowed. If your travel agent has not filled in these dates, then go to the ticket window at a train station and ask a member of staff to complete them for you. Some airports have railroad offices where you can have your pass validated (see page 15). If an on-board train conductor has to do it for you, you will have to pay a fee.

Your pass must be validated within 6 months of the date of issue.


You can begin your first journey after 00.00 hours on the first day of validity of your pass and you must finish your last trip by 24.00 hours on the last day of validity.




How often can I use my pass?

The number of journeys that your pass entitles you to depends on whether it is a 'flexi' pass or a 'consecutive' pass.

All Eurail Select, Regional and One Country Passes are flexi passes. Eurail Global Passes, however, can be either flexi passes or consecutive passes.

- Flexi passes  can only be used for a certain number of travel days within a set period. If you have a flexi pass, a travel calendar will be printed on your ticket (see the example pass next page).
- Consecutive passes can be used every day during the period in which the pass is valid.

In this booklet, any section marked with a  applies to flexi pass holders only.

❖ How do I fill in the travel calendar?

- With a flexi pass, you can travel on a set number of days within a given period. On each day that you decide to travel (use a travel day), you can hop on as many trains as you like.
- On each day you travel, before you board your first train, it is extremely important that you record the date in the travel calendar printed on the ticket (see the Eurail Pass example below). Not doing so is the same as traveling without a ticket, which means you risk a hefty fine or having your pass confiscated by the ticket inspector.
- Enter the day and the month in the correct boxes: write the day in the box marked 'Day', and the month in the box below, marked 'Mth'. Enter every travel day in a separate box and write in blue or black ink.

- Note that if you make a mistake when filling in the date, you will lose a travel day! You cannot correct a mistake as this could be interpreted as an attempt at fraud. You will have to enter the correct date in the next travel day box.
- Do not fill in the whole travel calendar at once: just record each travel day as and when you use your pass.

❖ What do I do if I make a mistake on the travel calendar?

If you do accidentally make a mistake when filling in the date on the travel calendar, do not correct it yourself. This may be interpreted as fraud. Instead, enter the correct date in the next travel day box. If you wish to do so, you may request to have your pass replaced, if you have incorrectly filled it in. Visit the nearest Eurail Aid office and ask them to do this. Note that you will incur a fee of approximately EUR 30 (or the equivalent in local currency).

❖ How do I enter an overnight journey in my travel calendar?

If you have a Pass with flexible travel days (i.e. 5 travel days within 10 days), there are 2 possibilities for traveling by night train:

1. In the event that your train departs **before** 19.00 hours, you need to use 2 travel days (fill in the day of departure and the day of arrival)

or

2. If you're traveling on a direct night train that departs **after** 19.00 hours, you may take advantage of a special rule which allows you to use just one of your travel days. If your first trip of the day is on a direct overnight train departing after 19:00 hours, enter the following day's date (i.e. the date of arrival) in the calendar box. For example: if, on August 2nd, you take the direct night train from Munich to Budapest departing at 23.45 hours; you only have to fill in August 3rd in the travel calendar (date of arrival!). Please note that you cannot start traveling before the first day of validity of your Pass.

What if I travel through a country not covered by my pass?

If part of any journey goes through a country not covered by your Pass (see the Eurail Timetable), you will need to buy a ticket for that section. It is best to do this before boarding the train, since buying tickets on the train will be more expensive.

Reservations



Making reservations and paying extra charges

To ensure you have a seat, it is possible to make a reservation for most trains. For certain European trains, such as the high-speed, international or night trains, reservations are compulsory. To find out whether reservations are compulsory, check an online timetable, the Eurail timetable or enquire with your travel agent or at a railway station.

On some trains, the number of seats available for Eurail Pass users may be limited (reservation is subject to availability), so you should make reservations as early as possible.** Reservation costs are not included in the price of your pass and vary depending on the country, the distance, the time of day and type of train.

Some trains require you to pay a surcharge, which includes a compulsory seat reservation and, sometimes, a drink, a meal or other perks.

*** If trains are fully booked you will have to pay for a full price ticket, or decide to travel on a different day and/or at a different time.*

Where can I make reservations?

If you prefer to book through a travel agent or online, we suggest you contact the agent through which you purchased your Eurail Pass for information on reservations and to make any required bookings. You can also make reservations in Europe by going to a ticket window at a railway station or by visiting one of Eurails'Aid Offices. These are sometimes identified with a Eurail window sticker (see below).



To get the best fare and ensure seat availability, we suggest you book as early as possible, preferably before your departure to Europe.

Train types

Not all trains are the same! There are many different types, each with its own advantages and offering different types of travel experiences.

High-speed trains

Want to get there really fast? There are many high-speed services that criss-cross Europe, and all of them have comfortable 1st and 2nd class cars and catering services. These trains are a good option for covering longer distances or if you simply prefer a faster, more comfortable way of traveling. Seat reservations are compulsory and a surcharge must be paid. More information about the level of this surcharge can be found on the reverse of the Eurail map.

Express trains

There is also a full schedule of domestic and international express trains that can get you to your destination quickly. These are commonly called InterCity (IC) or EuroCity (EC) trains. These trains sometimes require a reservation.

Local trains

Slow and easy – that's the pace of the countless local trains you'll find all throughout Europe. Meandering through small towns or farmlands, you'll see life in rural Europe up close and be sure to be far away from the tourist crowds. Local trains sometimes only have 2nd class cars.

Legendary scenic rail routes

Shimmering lakes, plunging gorges, snow-capped mountains, coastal splendors – Europe bursts with picturesque, back-country routes boasting breathtaking scenery. Try the line between Mainz and Koblenz along the Rhine, or Spain's Algeciras to Ronda train. There are many legendary tourist lines that traverse Europe's landscape. Eurail Passes are accepted on many of these trains, or will entitle you to a discount. Reservations are often required or recommended. See the Eurail map for a sample of Europe's most scenic routes.

Night trains

Imagine gently rocking to sleep to the rhythm of the rails and arriving at your destination the next morning relaxed, refreshed and ready for a day of sightseeing. European night trains serve Europe's major cities and offer a variety of sleeping accommodations to suit all budgets. Most overnight trains offer sleepers and couchettes, and some also have reclining seats.

If you're on a budget, consider a couchette or a reclining seat. Couchettes are mixed compartments (men and women together), with four open bunks in 1st class and four or six open bunks in 2nd class. A sheet, blanket and pillow are provided, but be prepared to sleep in your day clothes. Reclining seats are available on selected trains, and are generally only available in 2nd class.

For maximum comfort and privacy, reserve a sleeper in a 1st class (one or two passengers) or 2nd class (two or three passengers) compartment. Sleeper compartments usually have a private wash basin, and toilet facilities can be found down the corridor of the train. Some night trains also offer deluxe sleeper compartments with a private toilet and shower.

In order to travel on night trains, you must make a reservation and pay the appropriate supplement. Note that prices vary according to the degree of luxury and privacy of your chosen accommodation.

What are the Europeans trains like?

1st or 2nd class?

Whether or not you may travel 1st class, depends on the type of Eurail Pass you have bought. In order to travel in 1st class with a 2nd class pass, you will need to pay the difference in fare. Please note that some trains do not have 1st class cars, and on ships there is generally no class distinction. If you have a 1st class pass, you are not entitled to a refund if you have to travel 2nd class.

Will there be food on board?

Enquire at the station or check an online timetable to find out whether a train has a buffet or restaurant car. Many long-distance trains have full-service restaurant cars that offer breakfast, lunch and dinner. Others offer an at-seat meal service. On many trains, buffet and bar cars sell light meals throughout the trip, and vendors with food trolleys often pass through the carriages selling beverages and snacks. You can also consider taking your own meal!

Train station smarts and helpful hints

Train stations can be busy, exciting and sometimes overwhelming places. In Europe, they are generally quite safe, but those with a lot of tourist traffic can draw pickpockets. Keep a close eye on your valuables! Here are a few helpful tips.



Customs and passport checks on night trains are often conducted while you are sleeping. It is quite common for the car attendant to collect your Eurail Pass and passport in preparation for any border formalities. Your documents will be returned to you in the morning after you have enjoyed an uninterrupted night's sleep. Please check carefully that you have received your own travel documents.

Check your station!

Many larger cities have multiple train stations, and trains do not always stop at them all. Double check exactly which station you need to depart from so you don't miss your train. If there is a specific station in a city you want to arrive at, also check that the train you're taking actually does stop there. The last pages of the Eurail timetable show a selection of city maps indicating the location of specific stations.

Train schedule and platform information

Most European railways have a website where you can consult train schedules, platform information and more. Departure schedules and platforms are posted at all train stations. At larger ones, computerized boards provide up-to-the-minute information. On the platforms, you'll also usually find displays confirming the next train's departure time and destination.

Baggage

Most major railway stations have left-luggage offices or coin-operated lockers for storage of your luggage. Aboard the train, luggage racks are found above seats or at the end of the car, but do keep an eye on your baggage, as the railway is not responsible for lost or stolen bags. Since you will generally be carrying your baggage around yourself on your trip, it's a good idea to pack as light as possible.

Money

There's little need to pre-purchase traveler's cheques anymore, as you will find many ATMs affiliated with Plus (Visa) and Cirrus (Master card). Bring plastic- credit and/or debit cards along with money in hard cash as an emergency backup. It is good to travel with small cash as € 100 bank notes are not always accepted, due to the risk of fraud. Keep your cash in a safe place.

Getting on, off and seating on trains

You've checked the schedule and know the departure track, now you're ready to board! If you've made a reservation, you'll find the car and seat number printed on the ticket. Displays on platforms at some stations show the composition of long-distance and overnight trains, and indicate where your car will stop on the platform. Be ready to board the train the minute it arrives; station stops are often very short. You can see if a car is 1st or 2nd class by the numbers posted near the train's door or on a window (note that some trains have both classes in one car). Pay close attention to destination displays and/or car numbers near the door. Trains can be split and sent in different directions, so make sure the car you're in is going where you want to go.

Are we there yet?

Station stops aren't always announced, or may be announced in a foreign language you don't understand. Take note of your scheduled arrival time and the names of the last stations before your stop so you'll be prepared to exit the train when it arrives at your destination. Station names are clearly visible at platforms. Ask a railway employee or a local passenger if you're not sure.

Lounges

At some major stations you may find railway lounges reserved for select clients. These lounges are sometimes available to 1st class pass holders: please check locally to see if your pass qualifies you for access to these lounges.

Airport rail links to city centres

It's easier than ever to step off a flight and hop straight onto a train: a long list of European airports and major train stations are connected by frequent train services. The following airports have direct rail links:

❖ Rules for using extra pass benefits

When traveling on a flexi pass, please note that if the benefit entails free transportation, it requires the use of one of your travel days (this means you must use one day from the calendar box). In the case of a free overnight ferry, you may enter either the date of departure or the date of arrival in the calendar. If the benefit only entails a discount in price, then it is not necessary to use a travel day.

For free passage on international ferry routes, your pass must be valid for the country of departure AND the country of arrival. For discounted passage, your pass must be valid for the country of departure OR the country of arrival. And when traveling at a reduced rate, you may travel at any time, provided it is while your pass is valid, even if all the travel days in the calendar have been used up.

Usually, pass benefits must be secured locally. Sometimes you can make a reservation through a service provider's call centre. Always check in advance that the company you are dealing with actually honors the discount.

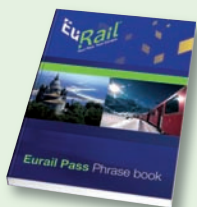
